Entry Requirements

- Holder of Diploma for Tertiary Studies or Diploma of Professional Studies (Building Technology) or Diploma of Professional Studies (Electrical) as awarded by HKCT with at least 1-year working experience; or
- Holder of Pre-Associate Degree with at least 1-year working experience; or
- Mature applicants aged 23 or above with at least 1-year relevant working experience; or
- Holder of Higher National Certificate (HNC) or holder of Higher Certificate in Civil Engineering with at least 1-year working experience can be considered for admission into Year 2; or
- Holder of other qualifications may be entitled to have course module exemption subject to maximum 50 percent of total number of credits.

Part-time 16 months

This programme admits students in September every year

Introduction

BSc (Hons) Civil Engineering is delivered by the Centre of International Education of the Hong Kong College of Technology and is awarded by Leeds Beckett University, UK.

Civil Engineers are responsible for designing, constructing and operating a wide range of infrastructure projects, including major structures, highways and water resources. Society's increasing concern for sustainability creates a challenge for more complex, yet innovative, cost-effective and environmentally sensitive solutions.

The programme provides a broad-based education enabling successful students taking this programme at the Hong Kong College of Technology to enter into careers in design, construction or operations in the civil engineering industry. In particular, the programme aims to create a range of learning opportunities which facilitate access and progression to allow personal and professional development.

Professional Qualification

The range and balance of modules on the course are designed to meet professional body requirements. The course has been accredited by the Hong Kong Institute of Clerks of Works (HKICW), the Chartered Association of Building Engineers (CABE) and the Hong Kong Institution of Incorporated Engineers (HKIIE).

Programme Structure⁺

This 16-month part-time programme is made up of six modules with a total of 120 credits as listed below.

Semester One

- Structural Engineering

Semester Two

- Geotechnical Engineering B

Semester Three

- Quantitative Methods for Decision Making
- Major Project

Semester Four

- Hydraulics and Water Engineering
- Major Project

Assessment

All courses are assessed by a mixture of coursework, essays, reports, project work and examination.

Entry Requirements

- ▶ Candidates who are holding a Higher Diploma in Civil Engineering or equivalent including the study of structural design and exhibit an overall average of at least 50% are eligible to apply for the course.
- ▶ Candidates who have no Higher Diploma qualification may be considered on a case-to-case basis, providing they possess an equivalent academic qualification.
- ▶ Candidates have at least two years of relevant working experience.

Laboratory Session

Appropriate laboratory demonstration will be provided.

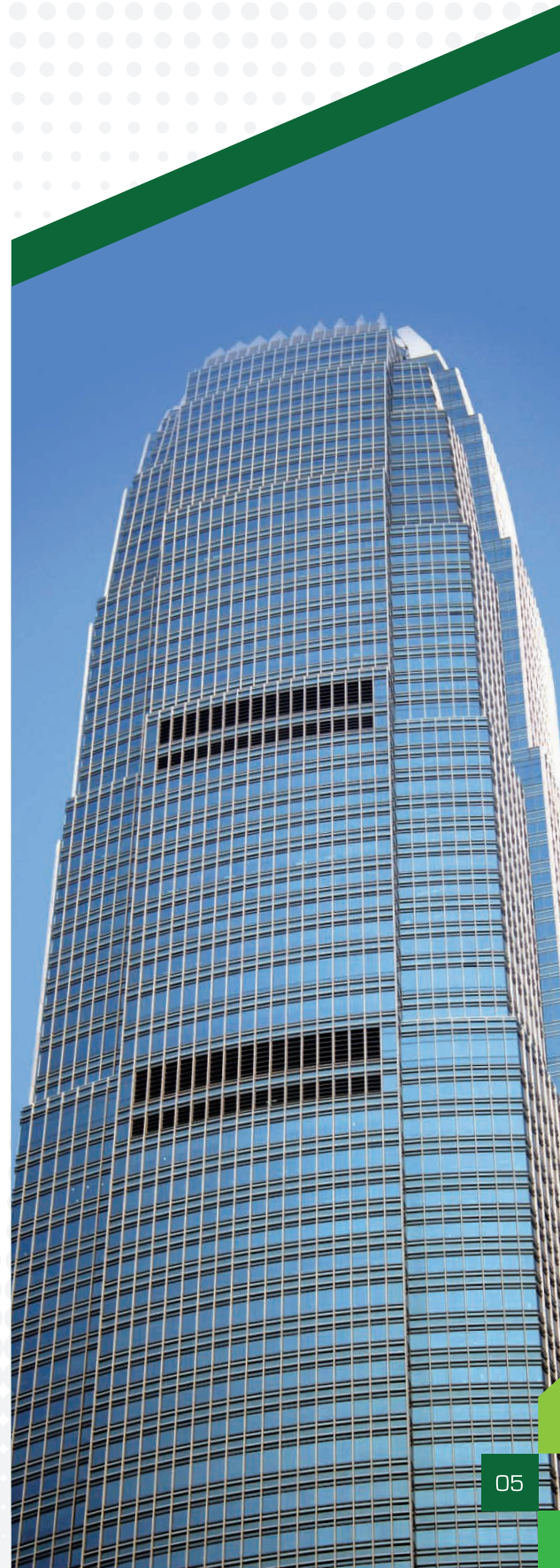

Part-time 2 years

This programme admits students in September every year

Introduction

MSc Civil Engineering is delivered by the Centre of International Education of Hong Kong College of Technology and is awarded by Leeds Beckett University, UK. This 2-year part-time masters programme provides the academic pathway for degree holders in relevant disciplines to obtain higher level of qualification.

Professional Qualification

This programme is accredited by Chartered Association of Building Engineers (CABE), graduates who fulfill specified education and professional development requirements are eligible to apply for Membership of CABE.



Programme Structure⁺

This 2-year part-time course is made up of six modules and a dissertation as listed below.

Entry Requirements

- ▶ Holders of BSc (Hons)/ BEng (Hons) in Civil Engineering (accredited for IEng) at 2.1 or above; or
- ▶ Holders of BEng (Hons) in Civil Engineering (accredited for partial CEng) at 2.2 or above; or
- ▶ Holders of Honours degree in relevant engineering subject at 2.1 or above; or
- ▶ Holders of other relevant non-cognate honours degree at 2.1 or above, with experience in specialist civil engineering; or
- ▶ Professionals who have substantial experience in Civil Engineering and who are i) holders of accredited civil HND or ii) an honours degree, or iii) mature applicants aged 23 or above who also possess an equivalent and relevant academic qualification; and
- ▶ Applicants should possess English language proficiency level up to IELTS 6.5 with no score lower than 6.0; or equivalent; and
- ▶ Applicants have at least three years of relevant working experience.
