

100% of BA (Hons) Graphic Design and BA (Hons) Graphic Communication UK graduates are in graduate-level employment, further study or training within six months of graduating, according to DLHE 2016/17 (based on full-time, first degree, home leavers).

The Design programmes at Sunderland have been winning top international design awards and accolades for almost three decades. The most recent successes include the D&AD 'The Best in Show' and the Adobe Students Creative Awards. According to University League Tables 2020, Sunderland Design & Crafts ranked 29th in subject.



The BA (Hons) Graphic Design aims at those who want to top up their sub-degree qualification to a full honors degree, or for those with extensive practical experience to be a professional graphic designer. The one year BA (Hons) Graphic Design Top-Up programme is offered at Hong Kong College of Technology and is awarded by University of Sunderland and it is a fast bridge programme to achieve a UK honors degree.

This module is your opportunity to demonstrate your creative, technical and organizational skill within an assignment or range of assignments of your own devising

Entry Requirements

Top-Up / Year 3 Entry:

General Requirements

- One of the following qualifications in graphic design or related discipline:
 - · Higher Diploma
 - · Associate Degree
 - · Professional Diploma

The qualification must be awarded by a local recognized institution / post-secondary college; OR

 Other qualifications, which the University will consider on a case-by-case basis; equivalent to the normal admission requirements of the University;

- Satisfactory portfolio
- Pass in English admission interview

English Requirements**

- ► IELTS 6.0 with no score below 5.5; OR
- Equivalent qualifications

Entry Requirements

Year 1 Entry Requirement(s):

- ► Level 2 in 5 HKDSE subjects with 1 year of relevant working experience; or
- Holder of Diploma with 1 year of relevant working experience; or
- Student aged 21 or above with 3 years of relevant working experience; or
- ▶ Equivalent Qualifications

Year 2 Entry Requirement(s):

- ► Holder of Higher National Certificate in related area with 1 year of relevant working experience; or
- ► Holder of Higher Certificate in related area with 1 year of relevant working experience; or
- Holder of Advanced/Professional/Higher Diploma or Associate Degree of other disciplines with 2 years of relevant working experience will be considered on a case-by-case basis; or
- Equivalent Qualifications
